11 **The one having an ear**
54 **let him hear**
 what the Spirit is saying to the churches.

The one overcoming
55 **will never be harmed**
 by the second death.

12 And
56 **to the angel at the church in Pergamum write:**
57 **These these says the One has the sharp two-edged sword:**

58 13 **I know**
 where you are living,
 where Satan's throne is,
 and
 you are holding fast to My name
 and
 you have not denied faith in Me
 and

 in the days
 of Antipas
 my faithful martyr
 who was killed among you
 where Satan lives.

14 But
59 **I have a few things against you,**
 because you have there those holding fast to the teaching of Balaam,
 /-----|
 who was teaching Balak
 to put a stumbling block
 before the sons of Israel
 so that they would eat food sacrificed to idols,
 and
 would commit fornication.

15 Thusly
60 **you have those holding fast to the teaching**
 likewise of the Nicolaitans.

16 Therefore
61 **repent;**
 and
 if not,
62 **I will come to you**
 quickly
 and
63 **I will wage war**
 against them,
 with the sward coming out of My mouth.

17 **The one having an ear**
64 **let hear**
 what the Spirit is saying to the churches.

 To the one overcoming
65 **I will give to him from the manna**
 that is hidden

66 **I will give to him a white stone**
and
on the stone
67 **(there is) written a new name**
which no one knows
except the one receiving (it).

68 **to the angel of the church in Thyatira write:**
69 **These things says the Son of God,**
the one having his eyes
like a flaming fire

70 **His feet (are) like burnished bronze;**

¹⁹ 71 **I know your works**
and
your love
and
your faith
and
your ministry
and
your endurance,
and
72 **your last works are greater than the first one.**

²⁰ But
73 **I have something against you,**
because you allow that woman Jezebel
who calls herself a prophetess
and
teaches

deceives my servants
to practice immorality
and
to eat meat offered to idols.

 97 **you have a few names**
 in Sardis
 that have not stained their clothes,
 and
 98 **they will walk**
 with me,
 in white
 because they are worthy.

3.5 **The one overcoming will so be clothed**
 in white garments
 and
 100 **I will not ever blot out his name**
 from the book of life
 and
 101 **I will confess his name**
 before My Father
 and
 before His angels.

3.6 The one having an ear
 102 **let him hear**
 what the Spirit is saying to the churches.

3.7 And
 103 **to the angel of the church in Philadelphia write:**

104 **These things says the Holy One,**
 the True One
 the One possessing the keys of David
 the One who opens and no one shuts
 and
 who closes and no one opens,

3.8 **I know your works,**
 Indeed,

106 I have put a door before you,
open
which no one can close
because you have some power
and
you have kept my word
and
you have not denied My name.

3.9 Indeed
107 I will make. . . of those calling themselves Jews
from the synagogue of Satan
and
108 they are not
but
109 they are lying.

Indeed,
110 I will make them
that they come
and
they bow down
before your feet

they will know

3.10 Because you have kept my word of patient endurance
111 I also will keep you
from the hour of testing
that is going to come
upon all the inhabitants

 118 to the angel of the church in Laodicea write:
 119 **These things says the Amen,**
 the faithful and true witness
 the originator of God's creation;
 120 3.19 **I know your works,**
 that you are neither cold nor hot.
 121 **Oh that you were cold or hot.**
 3.16 Thus
 because you are neither hot nor cold
 122 **I am going to spit you**
 out of my mouth.
 3.17 Because you say
 "I am rich
 and
 I have prospered
 and
 I have need of nothing"
 and
 you do not know
 that you are wretched
 and
 pitiable
 and
 poor
 and
 blind
 and
 naked,
 123 3.18 **I advise you to buy . . . gold**
 from Me
 refined in fire
 so that you may be rich,
 and
 garments
 white
 so that you may be clothed
 and
 -- ---- the shame of your nakedness will not be revealed
 and
 salve
 to anoint your eyes
 so that you may see.
 124 3.19 **Whomever I love I reprove**
 and
 125 ----- - ---- **I discipline;**
 Therefore
 126 **be earnest**
 and
 127 **repent.**

^{3.20} Indeed
128 I am standing
at the door
and
129 I am knocking;

If anyone hears My voice
and
opens the door,
also
130 I will come in
to him
and
131 I will dine
with him
and
132 he ---- ----
with Me.

^{3.21} The one overcoming
133 I will permit him to sit
with Me
at my throne
even as I have overcome
and
- sit
with My Father
at His throne.

^{3.22} The one having an ear
134 let him hear
what the Spirit is saying to the churches.

^{4.1} After these things,
135 I saw,
and
indeed
136 there was an opened door
in Heaven
and
137 a voice was there
the first one
which I heard
like a trumpet
speaking
with me
saying,
Come up here,
and
I will show you
the things necessary to happen
after these things.

^{4.2} Immediately
138 I was
in the Spirit
and
indeed
139 there stood a throne
in Heaven,

and
 upon the throne
 140 **there sat One**
 4.3 and
 141 **the One sitting was**
 like a transparent stone
 of jasper and carnelian,
 and
 142 **a rainbow was**
 encircling the throne
 like a transparent emerald.
 4.4 And
 encircling the throne
 143 **there were twenty four thrones**
 and
 upon the thrones
 144 **there were twenty-four elders**
 sitting
 clothed
 in white robes,
 and
 upon their heads
 145 there were golden crowns.
 4.5 And
 from the throne
 146 **there were coming out flashes of lightening and noises and claps of thunder,**
 and
 147 **there were seven lamps of burning fire**
 before the throne
 which are the seven spirits of God,
 4.6 and
 before the throne
 148 **there was something**
 as a sea of glass
 like crystal.
 And
 in the midst of the throne
 and
 encricled around the throne
 149 **there were four living creatures**
 full of eyes
 in front and behind.
 4.7 And
 150 **the first living creature was**
 like a lion
 and
 151 **the second living creature was**
 like an ox
 and
 152 **the third living creature was**
 having the face
 as a man
 and
 153 **the third living creature was**
 like a flying eagle.

160 And
I saw an angel
strong
proclaiming
in a loud voice:
Who is worthy
to open the scroll
and
to loose its seals?

5.3
161 And
no one was able
in heaven |
neither upon the earth |
nor under the earth |
to open the scroll
or
to look in it.

5.4
162 And
I began weeping
bitterly,
because no one was found worthy
to open the scroll
or
to look in it.

5.5
163 And
one of the elders says to me:
stop weeping
indeed there stands the Lion
| from the tribe of Judah
| the Root of David
to open the scroll
and
its seven seals.

5.6
164 And
I saw
in the midst of the throne |
and |
of the four living|creatures
and |
in the midst of the elders |
a Lamb
standing
as slaughtered
having seven horns
and
seven eyes
/-----|
which are the seven spirits of God
sent out
into all the earth.

5.7
165 And
He went
and
166 **He took (the scroll)**
out of the right hand

of the One sitting on the throne.

5.8 And

167 **the four living creatures and the twenty-four elders fell down** when he took the scroll
before the Lamb
each one holding a harp
and
bowls
/-----|
golden
full of incense
which are the prayers of the saints,

5.9 and

168 **they chant a new song**
saying,
"Worthy are you
to take the scroll
and
to open its seals
because you were slaughtered
| and
you ransomed to God (saints)
| by your blood
| out of every tribe
| and
| tongue
| and
| people
| and
| nation
| and
you made them to our God
| a kingdom
| and
| priests,
| and
they are reigning
upon the earth.

5.11 And

169 **I saw**
and
170 **I heard a voice of angels**
many
in a circle around the throne
and
the living creatures
and
the elders,

and

171 **the number of them was myriads of myriads**
| and
| **thousands of thousands**

saying
in a loud voice,
Worthy is the Lamb
| which was slaughtered
to receive the power

and
riches
and
wisdom
and
might
and
honor

glory

blessing!

5.13 And

every creature
in heaven
and
on earth
and
under the earth
and
upon the sea

and

all the things in them

172 | **I heard**
saying,

"to the One sitting on the throne
and

to the Lamb (be) blessing

forever and ever!

5.14 And

173 **the four living creatures were saying,**

Amen!

And

174 **the elders fell down**

and

175 **--- ----- worshiped.**

6.1 And

176 **I saw**

when the Lamb opened the first one

from the seven seals,

and

177 **I heard one**

from the four living creatures

saying

as a voice of thunder,

Come!

6.2 And

178 **I saw,**

and
behold
179 **(there was) a white horse**
and
180 **(there was) one sitting**
upon it
holding a bow
and
181 **there was given to him a crown**
and
182 **he came out**
conquering
and
to conquer.

6.3
And
when He opened the second seal
183 **I heard the second living creature**
saying,
"Come!"

6.4
And
184 **out came another horse, bright red,**
and
to the one sitting
upon it
185 **there was given to him,**
to take peace
out of the earth
| and
/-|
so that they would slaughter one another
and
186 **was given to him a great sword.**

6.5
And
when he opened the third seal
187 **I heard the third living creature,**
saying,
"Come!"

And
188 **I saw,**
and
behold
189 **(there was) a black horse,**
and
190 **(there was) one sitting**
upon it
holding a pair of scales
in his hand

and
191 **I heard**
as a voice
in the midst of the four living creatures
saying,
"A liter
of wheat for a denarius,
and

three liters
of barley for a denarius

the olive oil and the wine do not harm."

when He opened the fourth seal
192 **I heard the voice,**
of the fourth living creature
saying,
"Come!"

193 **I saw**
and
behold
194 **(there was) a pale green horse,**
and
195 **(there was) one sitting**
on top of it
whose name (was) Death
and
196 **Hades was following**
with him
and
197 **was given to them the authority**
upon the four corners |
of the|earth
to kill
with sword
and
with famine
and
with pestilence
and
by the wild animals of the earth.

And
when he opened the fifth seal,
198 **I saw the souls**
under the|altar
of those having been slaughtered
because of the Word of God
and
because of the witness
that they were having.

And
199 **they cried out**
with a loud voice,
saying:
"Until when,
Master,
holy and true,
will you not judge
and
will you not avenge our blood
from those dwelling
upon the earth?"

 200 **was given to them, to each one, a white robe**

 206 **the stars of heaven fell**
 to the earth
 as a fig tree casts off its unripe fruit
 under the shaking of a gale-force wind,

6.14 and
 207 **the sky was split apart**
 as a scroll rolling itself up
 and
 from their place
 208 **every mountain and island...was removed.**

6.15 And
 209 **the kings of the earth**
 and
 the great men
 and
 the tribunes
 and
 the rich
 and
 the powerful
 and
 every slave
 and
 freedman hid themselves
 in the caves
 and
 in the rocks of the mountains

6.16 and
 210 **they say to the mountains**
 and
 211 ---- --- **to the rocks,**

Fall
upon us
and
hide us
from the face
of the One sitting
upon the throne
and
from the wrath
of the Lamb
because the great day of their wrath has come
and
who is able to stand?

7.1 After this

212 **I saw four angels**
standing
on the four corners of the earth,
holding back the four winds of the earth,
so that no wind might blow
on the earth
nor on the sea
nor on every tree.

7.2 And

213 **I saw another angel**
ascending
from the rising of the sun
possessing the seal of the Living God,

and

214 **he cried out. . . to the four angels**
in a loud voice
| to whom was given to them |
| /-----|
| to harm the earth
| and
| the sea
saying:
Do not harm the earth
nor the sea
nor the trees
until we may seal the slaves of our God
upon their foreheads.

7.4 And

215 **I heard the number**
of those **sealed**
one hundred forty four thousand,
sealed
out of every tribe of the sons of Israel:
7.5 out of the tribe of Judah twelve thousand **sealed,**
out of the tribe of Reuben twelve thousand,
7.6 out of the tribe of Gad twelve thousand,
out of the tribe of Asher twelve thousand,
out of the tribe of Naphtalie twelve thousand,
out of the tribe of Manasseh twelve thousand,
7.7 out of the tribe of Simeon twelve thousand,
out of the tribe of Levi twelve thousand,

7.8 out of the tribe of Issachar twelve thousand,
out of the tribe of Zebulum twelve thousand,
out of the tribe of Joseph twelve thousand,
out of the tribe of Benjamin twelve thousand **sealed**.

7.9 After these things
216 **I saw,**
and
behold
217 **(there was) a large crowd,**
which no one was able to number it
out of every nation and tribes and peoples and tongues
standing before the throne
clothed with white robes
and
with palm branches in their hands,

7.10 and
218 **they are shouting**
with a loud voice
saying,
Salvation (be)
to our God
who sits
upon the throne
and
to the Lamb.

7.11 And
219 **all the angels stood**
in a circle around the throne
and
around the elders
and
around the four living creatures,

220 and
they fell down
before the throne
upon their faces

221 and
they worshiped God
saying,

amen, -----
blessing
and
glory
and
wisdom
and
thanksgiving
and
honor
and
power
and
strength (be) to our God'
forever and ever
amen. -----

7.13
 222 And
One asked
 out of the elders
 saying to me,
 Who are these who are clothed with white robes,
 and
 from where have they come?

7.14
 223 And
I said to him,
 My lord,
 you know.

 And
 224 **he said to me,**
A *These are the ones coming*
 out of the great tribulation,
 and
B *they have washed their robes*
 and
C *they have made them white*
 in the blood of the Lamb.

7.15
D Because of this
they are
 before the throne of God
 and
E *they serve him*
 day and night
 in His temple,
 and
F *the one sitting . . . puts His tent*
 upon the throne
 upon them.

7.16
G *They are not thirsty*
 still
H *neither are they hungry*
 still
I *nor does the sun burn down*
 on them
J *nor does any heat ---- ----*

7.17
 because the Lamb . . . will shepherd them
 in the middle of the throne
 and
 He will guide them
 to the life of spring water
 and
 God will wipe away every tear
 out of their eyes.

8.1
 225 And
 when He opened the seventh seal,
silence happened
 in heaven
 about half an hour.

8.2
 226 And
I saw seven angels
 who were standing before God,

and
227 was given to them seven trumpets.

8.3 And
228 another angel came
and
229 was made to stand
at the altar
while possessing a golden censer
and
230 was given to him much incense
so that he would give (it)
with the prayers
of all the saints
upon the altar
golden
before the throne.

8.4 and
231 rose up the smoke of the incenses
with the prayers of the saints
out of a hand of the angel
before God.

8.5 and
232 took the angel the censer
and
233 he filled it
out of the fire of the altar
and
234 he threw (it)
onto the earth
and
235 happened peals of thunder and rumblings and flashes of lightening and an earthquake

8.6 And
236 the seven angels . . . prepared themselves
who possessed| the seven trumpets
in order that they might blow the trumpets.

8.7 And
237 *the first one blew;*
and
238 happened hail and fire
mixed
in blood
and
239 (it) was thrown
into the earth
and
240 the third of the earth was burned up
and
241 the third of the trees was burned up
and
242 all green grass was burned up.

8.8 And
243 *the second angel blew;*
and

like a great mountain
burning with fire
244 (something) was thrown
into the sea,
and
245 the third of the sea became blood
8.9 and
246 died the third of the living creatures
| of those in the sea
the ones having life
and
247 the third of the ships were destroyed.

8.10 And
248 the third angel blew;
and
249 fell . . . a star
out of heaven great
blazing
like a torch
and
250 fell
upon the third of the rivers
and
upon the third of the springs of waters
8.11 and
251 the name of the star is being called Wormwood,
and
252 became the third of the waters
into wormwood (bitterness)
and
253 many of the men died
out of the waters
because they were made bitter.

8.12 And
254 the fourth angel blew;
and
255 was struck the third of the sun
| and
| the third of the moon
| and
| the third of the stars
so that was darkened the third of them
and
-- ---- the day would not appear
and
-- ---- the night likewise.

8.13 And
256 I saw
and
257 I heard one of the eagles
flying
in mid-heaven
saying:
in a loud voice

Woe, woe, woe -- to those dwelling
| on the earth

and
 271 **they will long to die**
 and
 272 **death will flee**
 from them.

9.7 And
 273 **the appearance of the locusts is like**
 horses
 being prepared for war,
 and
 upon their heads
 274 **(there was)**
 like crowns
 like gold
 and
 275 **their faces (were)**
 like human faces,

9.8 and
 276 **they had hairs**
 like the hairs of women
 and
 277 **their teeth...were**
 like (those) of lions.

9.9 And
 278 **they had breastplates**
 like iron breastplates
 and
 279 **the noise of their wings (was)**
 like the noise of chariots
 of many horses
 running into war.

9.10 And
 280 **they have tails**
 like (those) on scorpions
 and
 stingers
 and
 in their tails
 281 **their authorization (is) to harm men**
 for five months,

9.11 and
 282 **they have . . . a king**
 over them the angel of the abiss
 283 **a name (has) to him in Hebrew Abaddon**
 and
 in Greek
 284 **his name (is) Apollyon.**

9.12 **The first woe has passed;**
 Behold
 286 **two woes are still coming.**

9.13 And
 287 **the sixth angel blew;**
 and

288 **I heard a single voice**
 out of the four horns
 | of the altar
 | golden
 | before God,
 9.14 saying to the sixth angel,
 having the trumpet,
Release the four angels
 /-----|
 who are chained
 at the large river the Euphrates.

9.15 And
 289 **were loosed the four angels**
 who are prepared
 for the hour and day and month and year
 in order that they may kill the third of men.

9.16 And
 290 **the number of the soldiers (equals) two hundred million,**
 291 **I heard their number.**

9.17 And
 thus
 292 **I saw the horses**
 in the vision
 and
those sitting
 on them
 having breastplates
 of fiery red
 and
 of hyacinth blue
 and
 of sulfur,
 and
 293 **the heads of the horses (were)**
 like heads of lions,
 and
 out of their mouths
 294 **are coming fire and smoke and sulfur.**

9.18
 295 **were killed the third of men,**
 out of the fire and the smoke and the sulfur
 which is coming
 out of their mouths.

9.19 For
 296 **the authorization of the horses...is**
 in their mouths
 and
 in their tails,
 for
 297 **their tails (were)**
 like serpents
 having heads,
 and

298 with them
they do harm.

9.20 And
299 the rest of the men . . . do not repent
who were not killed |
by these plagues |
out of the works of their hands,
lest they will worship the demons
and
the idols
gold
and
silver
and
bronze
and
stone
and
wood
/-----|
which things are able neither to see
nor to hear
nor to walk

9.21 and
300 they did not repent
from their murders
301 neither (did they repent)
from their sorceries
302 nor (did they repent)
from their fornication
303 nor (did they repent)
from their thefts.

10.1 And
304 I saw another angel
strong
coming down
out of heaven
clothed in a cloud,
and
305 a rainbow (was)
upon his head
and
306 his face (was)
like the sun
and
307 his feet (were)
like pillars of fire.

10.2 And
308 he possessed . . . a small scroll
in His hand opened.

And
309 he placed his right foot
upon the sea,
but
310 (he placed) his left foot
upon the land,

10.3
311 and
he cried out
in a loud voice
like a lion roars.

and
when he cried out
312 **spoke seven thunders in their own sound.**

10.4
And
when the seven thunders spoke
313 **I was going to write,**
and
314 **I heard a voice**
from heaven
saying:
Seal up
the things which the seal thunders spoke,
and
315 **these things I did not write.**

10.5
And
316 **the angel . . . raised his right hand**
whom I saw stand|ing
up|on the sea
| and
up|on the land
into heaven

10.6
and
