The following indicates individuals and situations that we as members of the International Baptist Church in Cologne need to be praying for daily.

1. Bro. Ordi Hossau, who served God on a mission trip in villages located in Indonesia this summer. He will be bringing a report to the church in the next few weeks about his experience. Continue praying for him as he prepares to begin a new semester the theological studies this fall.
2. Bro. Wilfred Samuriwo, who is recovering from surgery on his shoulder.
3. Bro. Joe Phiri, who is recovering from lung problems.
4. Baby Helen and her parents, Joy and Jenor, as she remains in a coma.
5. Calvin and Betty Ann Hogue. We give thanks for their safe arrival in Germany and the wonderful beginning service last Sunday. Pastor, we pledge to pray for God's blessings on your leadership of the church in the coming months.
6. Sister Vivian von Piechowski, that she will have a successful pregnancy and birth in October. The doctor has put her on bed rest to protect the baby.
7. Zimbabwe, that peace may return to this troubled country, and that believers in Christ may have opportunity to give witness to the love of God to their fellow countrymen during this time of chaos. And for other countries caught up in war and strive, especially the country of Georgia in the conflict over South Ossetia.
8. Pastor Lorin and Claire as they begin the process of selling their home in North Carolina and preparing for the move to Germany in December.
9. For formerly members of IBC church Cologne, that many of them will find God leading them to return to active service in our church.
10. For the First Baptist Church, Shelby NC. 11. For wives everywhere longing to become mothers.
 13. Stephen Nganga, a young man from Kenya, who has lost his job and is now seeking a new position. He requests our prayers.
 14. For the world wide ministries of Christ to the World Ministries (CTTW). Pastor Lorin has served for several years as biblical and theological editor, as well as writer, for this Texas based organization that broadcasts radio dramas and Bible studies to over 100 million people scattered all the way from eastern Russia to China and Korea. This summer we are developing materials to reach millions of people in Outer Mongolia through radio broadcasts. Broadcasts over most of India began on July 6 and will continue for several months.
 15. For a Christian witness in the follow up ministry after the Olympic games in Peking, China. Many Christian groups are seeking to reach out to the many individuals who expressed interest in Christianity during the games.
 16. For Claire's two sisters, Wanda and Nancy, in Texas. One is a Christian and the other is not, but both are struggling with health problems and job problems.
 17. Stefanie Wöhler who lost her grandmother on Friday, July 29. We want to lift up Stefanie as she tries to be a Christian witness to her family during these days of bereavement, as well as with personal health issues.
 18. For those seeking jobs, and even a new job.
 19. For the ministry of the IBC churches in Spain as they seek to minister to those who lost loved ones in the plane crash earlier. Especially pray for Pastor David Dixon of the IBC Church Madrid, who is helping some of the Baptist families cope with grief over the lost of loved ones in the accident. Pray especially for the family of Bro. Ruben Santana, co-pastor in charge of evangelism at the Tres Cantos Baptist Church, a suburb of Madrid. He was killed in the plane crash.
